
DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

BY THE NUMBERS

NUMBER of CHILDREN SERVED SINCE INCEPTION - 406

2021 NUMBERS

- 146 families served
- 38,000 meals served to children
- Managed costs under \$25 per child per day to feed, care and educate
(based on 2021 budget and attendance - includes 2 meals, 1 snack, full-time daycare and education)
- The Gospel was shared 279 times with families or individuals
- 8 salvations
- 253 volunteers
- 1,244 volunteer hours
- 168 early intervention hours for occupational & speech therapy
- 100% percent of our parents have maintained employment
- 100% of our families attended trainings offered through NHC
- 60% of our 2021 graduating class mastered **all** areas of the TSR
(Texas School Ready) state standard requirements

TELYITH'S STORY



My name is Telyith. Before I heard about Nabor House, I was running from an abusive relationship. I made the decision to move to Texas to give my son Leonardo and myself a start over. My sister told me about Nabor House, and I called right away. When I met the [center] directors, they presented and shared with me all about Jesus. I had been hurting for so long and the prayer, the words, the love that was shared with me was what I needed desperately. I can testify that has transformed my life. I feel God with me all the time – in good times and in bad times. I am grateful for Nabor House because after that prayer I have felt the peace that I was seeking. At the [2021] Fall Festival I felt like I needed to let God know that I want Him in my life. I'm new at this, so I just tell Him all the time that now I want to be with Him. He has been so good to me – He provided the daycare for my son and a new job opportunity for me.

Jerry Stoller envisioned a childcare facility, birth to preschool, that provided single mothers the opportunity to pursue employment, education, and a better future for their families. He also knew children learned better in a safe environment. In 2013, Jerry founded a nonprofit Christian childcare center. Inspired by his years spent at the University of Illinois, he named the Houston-based charity Nabor House Community after his first collegiate home, the Nabor House Fraternity.

Jerry had a heart for single mothers and low-income families and felt a sense of responsibility to help them and their children become self-sufficient and independent. He did so by offering a "hand-up" rather than a "hand-out." Today, Nabor House Community has not only served over 400 children, but has also enriched the lives of entire families through the power and love of Jesus Christ.
